## **FPL is Ditching Overdue Fines and Fees**

Have you heard? Starting February 1st, 2025, the Freeport Public Library is no longer charging or collecting fees for late items!

Returning late due to being out of town? No problem!

Keeping a book a few days longer so you can finish? We've been there!

Found a book in a pile of kids' toys while you were moving and you're afraid to come back to the library because of how many fees you have?

We understand life happens! Welcome back!

FPL is proud to be a fine free library. This means that we do not charge overdue fines on most library materials. When overdue items are returned, they are checked in and no overdue charges are assessed. If items are not returned or are returned damaged then a fee will be assessed.

Overdue fines are widely recognized by professional library organizations as a form of social inequity. <u>The American Library</u> <u>Association</u> and others have conducted multiple studies that show that imposing fines neither teaches responsibility nor motivates borrowers to return items on time.

# What happens to my existing fines?

Any outstanding late fines on FPL items will be purged from our patron accounts starting February 1st, 2025.

# Will all items be "Fine Free"?

All of our items will be fine free with the exception of Hotspots, STEM Kits, Parent Kits, and Library of Things items.

#### - What if I have overdue items?

Borrowing privileges will be suspended for patrons with significantly overdue material. For lost and damaged items, the cost of the item(s) will still be charged to the patron's account.
